



BREAST CANCER

BREAST CANCER IS COMMON AND LETHAL

It is the commonest malignancy among women worldwide (11.7% of all cancer cases) as well as in India (13.5% of all cancer cases). The incidence rate in India increased 39% between 1990 1nd 2016; current trends show a higher proportion of disease occurring at younger age in Indian women. In India 1 in 2 women die of the disease compared to 1 in 5-6 in western countries. This is due to earlier age at onset, late stage at diagnosis, delayed initiation of definitive management and inadequate, suboptimal and fragmented treatment.

BREAST CANCER IS PREVENTABLE

Hereditary predisposition accounts for 10-15% of all breast cancers; genetic testing is now widely available. The risk is also high for women who have a family history of breast cancer especially in a first-degree relative. Modifiable risk factors that increase risk are obesity, alcohol, combination hormone therapy, menopausal hormone therapy, estrogen therapy and ionising radiation. Those factors that decrease risk include early pregnancy, breast-feeding, and physical exercise.

EARLY DETECTION SAVES LIVES

5-year overall survival for stage I and II breast cancer is over 90%, for stage III it is 65% and for stage IV it is 25%. The cost of treatment also escalates with stage. Increased awareness, breast self-examination, clinical breast examination and appropriate screening with ultrasound and mammography are the tools used. Awareness-based early detection and risk-based screening strategies contribute significantly in increasing survival.

MULTIDISCIPLINARY MANAGEMENT KEY TO IMROVING OUTCOMES

The plethora of available treatment options needs optimal titration in each case to improve cure rates. Appropriate sequencing of modality, choice of procedure or drug, monitoring treatment responses and supportive care should be planned and executed under a multidisciplinary team. The right treatment in the right patient at the right time in the right way is the goal in breast cancer.

BIOLOGY IS KING

Current treatment protocols revolve around the molecular subtype of breast cancer as opposed to a predominant anatomical approach. Hormone-receptor (HR) status, HER-2 Neu status and proliferation index Ki-67 need to be determined by tissue evaluation PRIOR to initiation of therapy; hence a core-needle biopsy becomes mandatory in all cases and FNAC should only be used selectively. HR positive tumours are usually less aggressive, HER-2 positive more aggressive and TNBC the most aggressive subtype with corresponding better to worst prognosis.

SURGERY FOR BREAST CANCER

Standard-of-care for early breast cancer is Breast conservation surgery with Sentinel lymph node-directed management of the axilla. BCS is usually performed by selection of an appropriate oncoplastic procedure that allows best combination of tumour excision and cosmesis. Mastectomy is performed only in selected cases based on extensive, multisite, or in situ disease, recurrence or strong patient preference. Breast oncoplasty and conservation is also extensively used in locally advanced breast cancer after giving

chemotherapy upfront, limiting the need to perform mastectomy. SLNB identifies patients with positive axillary nodes that mandate a complete axillary clearance avoiding unnecessary complications (lymphoedema, seroma, numbness, pain etc.) in those with negative nodal status.

SYSTEMIC TREATMENT FOR BREAST CANCER

Advances in systemic treatment in recent years is responsible for the significant and dramatic improvement in survival from breast cancer. Appropriate escalation or de-escalation has improved outcomes and reduced treatment-related toxicity. Dose-dense chemotherapy schedules, dual HER-2 blockade for HER-2 positive breast cancer, post-neoadjuvant capecitabine and platinum-based regimens for TNBC patients, extended endocrine therapy for HR positive patients, immunotherapy with checkpoint inhibitors(PD-1/PDL-1) are examples of the changing landscape in this rapidly evolving field. The use of Neoadjuvant chemotherapy is now standard-of-care for locally advanced, HER-2 positive and triple negative breast cancers. In case of partial pathological response, alternative drugs would be recommended as adjuvant therapy (eg. TDM-1 in HER-2 positive BC). The combination of targeted therapy and endocrine therapy (eg. Aromatase inhibitors with Palbociclib/abemaciclib) is common in advanced cancers.

RADIATION THERAPY FOR BREAST CANCER

Advances in radiation therapy include hypofractionation techniques, better dose delivery, customisation of radiation fields based on tumour extent and biology, avoidance of radiation in certain low-risk populations. Avoiding radiation-related morbidity, especially cardiac, is a current focus area.

CONCLUSION

The management of breast cancer is complex and challenging as newer advances are the only constant. Survival has improved significantly, multidisciplinary approach is the norm, and shared decision making with the patient mandatory. Every breast cancer patient deserves access to the benefits of modern cancer care; nothing more and certainly nothing less.

Role of Radiation therapy in cancer treatment- Changing Landscape

Treatments for cancer care have grown multi-fold across the globe, and regardless of the types of cancer and their severity, there is hope for recovering from the same. For a layperson, terms like surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation may sound familiar. But there are a lot of scientific and medical decisions that go into administering these treatments.

Radiation is a common, and perhaps the oldest treatment for cancers. Also known by various names, including radiation therapy, radiotherapy, irradiation, and x-ray therapy, the use of radiation in healthcare is over a 100-year-old technique. Yet, it has advanced incredibly in treating cancers and incorporates the various safety frontiers and measures for a better prognosis.

What Is Radiation Therapy?

Radiation therapy is administered using high-energy waves or particles, including x-rays, gamma rays, protons, and electron beams to destroy the malignant cells. Radiation damages DNA of cells either directly or indirectly, through the formation of free radicals and reactive oxygen species. Radiation therapy is prescribed for cancer patients depending on the type and stage of the cancer. More than half (about 60%) of people with cancer have radiation therapy. Sometimes, radiation may suffice for the entire treatment, but is often offered in combination with other therapies.

· The goals of radiation therapy include:

- Definitive Radiation Therapy- To cure patient using only radiation as treatment modality in early stage cancer.
- Neo-Adjuvant RT- Shrinking or eliminating the cancer cells if the cancer is in an advanced stage before surgery.
- Adjuvant RT- To prevent the recurrence of cancer and stop them from spreading to other parts
 of the body after Surgery or Chemotherapy.
- 4) Palliative RT- For symptomatic relief from conditions, including pain, inability to breathe easily, blockages in the bowel, etc., in the advanced stages of cancer.

Is radiation therapy used with other types of cancer treatment?

Yes, radiation therapy is often used with other cancer treatments.

- Radiation therapy and surgery.
 Radiation may be given before, during, or after surgery. Doctors may use radiation to shrink
 the size of the cancer before surgery, or they may use radiation after surgery to kill any cancer
 cells that remain. Sometimes, radiation therapy is given during surgery, so that it goes straight
 to the cancer without passing through the skin. Radiation therapy given during surgery is
 called intraoperative radiation.
- Radiation therapy and chemotherapy.
 Radiation may be given before, during, or after chemotherapy. Before or during chemotherapy, radiation therapy can shrink the cancer so that chemotherapy works better. After chemotherapy, radiation therapy can be used to kill any cancer cells that remain.

Does radiation therapy hurt?

No, radiation therapy does not hurt while it is being given.

What is External beam radiation therapy?

External beam radiation therapy comes from a machine that aims radiation at your cancer. The machine is large and may be noisy. It does not touch you, but it can move around you, sending radiation to your body from many directions. External beam radiation therapy is a local treatment, meaning that the radiation treats a specific part of your body. For example, if you have lung cancer, you will have radiation only to your chest, not to the rest of your body.

The patient does not need to follow any specific precautions after returning home after the treatment.

Different techniques utilized in of External radiations are as follows:

- Stereotactic Radio surgery (SRS) and Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT)
 Stereotactic Radio surgery (SRS) is a highly-advanced, non-invasive radiotherapy treatment that
 delivers very intense doses of radiation to cancer cells. When this treatment is administered to the
 other parts of the body besides the brain, it is referred to as Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT)
 or Stereotactic Ablative Radiotherapy (SABR). SRS and SBRT are highly-effective in treating very
 tiny but well-defined tumours in inaccessible parts of the body, which are tough to remove
 surgically. With the help of advancements in technology, high doses of radiation are provided
 within a short duration to remove the tumour.
- Intensity Modulated Radiotherapy (IMRT): High-precision RT that improves the ability to conform the treatment volume to concave tumour shapes.

- Volumetric modulated arc therapy (VMAT): Novel radiation therapy technique that delivers the
 radiation dose continuously as the treatment machine rotates. It has shorter dose delivery time thu
 improving patients comfort and reducing the possibility of intrafraction motion. Decreased number of
 monitor units diminishes scattered radiation which was indicated to be the cause of second
 malignancies. Improved homogeneity and conformity index, as well as dose reduction on OARs
- Image-guided radiation therapy (IGRT)
 Image-Guided RT (IGRT) Repeated imaging scans (CT, MRI or PET) are performed daily while pt is
 on treatment table. Allows to identify changes in a tumour's size and/or location and allows the
 position of the patient or dose to be adjusted during treatment as needed. Can increase the
 accuracy of radiation treatment (reduction in the planned volume of tissue to be treated) decrease
 radiation to normal
- Four-dimensional radiation therapy (4DRT) Also called respiratory gating, is a radiation treatment
 used to target tumors that move with a patient's breathing, such as lung, pancreatic, and other
 gastrointestinal cancers. When respiratory gating is used, the physicians select the proper segment
 of the patient's breathing cycle to deliver treatment. The patient's breathing cycle is tracked during
 treatment using specialized cameras and the radiation beams are only turned on during the pre
 determined portion of the breathing cycle when tumor motion is as minimal as possible.

Understanding Precision Oncology

Precision medicine

Before understanding the concept of precision oncology, we need to look into the term precision medicine. Precision medicine is about matching the right drugs or treatments to the right people, based on a genetic or molecular understanding of their disease. It is an approach to patient care that is based on the idea that all patients' disease is not exactly the same Precision medicine attempts to understand more about variations in our genes, proteins and other factors that influence our health. The area of precision medicine that addresses treatments decisions for various cancers type is called precision oncology.

Precision Oncology

Precision Oncology can be simply defined as molecular profiling of tumors to identify targetable genetic alterations and has entered the mainstream of clinical practice in a big way. Tumors have multiple genetic changes that give advantage to cancer cell to proliferate and metastasize. The genetic changes that occur in one person's cancer may not occur in others who have the same type of cancer. It is now understood that every person's cancer is unique to them, comprised of a distinct combination of gene mutations and other cellular changes. Precision oncology is important to understand because a treatment that helps one person's cancer doesn't always work for somebody else.

What are the benefits of Precision Oncology?

The precision oncology strategy takes individual genetics in consideration to create treatment options designed specifically for that individual and others with similar molecular changes. This involves analyzing tumor tissue or blood and as appropriate using "targeted treatments", which are drugs or other substances that kill cancer cells. Unlike chemotherapy, targeted treatments cause fewer and less severe side effects. Precision oncology is transforming the way Oncologists are treating cancer patients.

Earliest example of Precision oncology is treatment of the BCR-ABL rearrangement in chronic myeloid leukemia by the small molecule Imatinib in year 1998, leading to dramatic clinical benefit. An example in solid tumor oncology was the ability to test for HER2 positivity as defined as fluorescent in situ hybridization—based gene amplification or immunohistochemistry to demonstrate overexpression of the this protein. Positive results predicted response to trastuzumab-based therapies, whereas HER2-negative tumors did not derive benefit from this approach. Testing of EGFR mutation in patient with advanced Adenocarcinoma Lung has made paradigm shift in treatment of this cancer with oral targeted therapy with Gefitinib and Erlotinib with minimal adverse events as compared to chemotherapy.

Next-Generation DNA Sequencing (NGS)

The most fundamental requirement for precison oncology is , a genomic test with clinical utility which should be predictive of a treatment response from a targeted agent. Next-Generation DNA Sequencing (NGS) testing on tumour tissue has now become backbone for treatment of patient by Precision Oncology. A range of genomic somatic variants can be ascertained with NGS, including single nucleotide variants (SNVs), i.e. point mutations, small insertions or deletions of bases. Additionally, copy number variants, which reflect amplifications and deletions of genes and/or larger portions of a chromosome, gene rearrangements and fusion genes can be detected.

Who and When to do NGS test

Many patients with metastatic disease may be good candidates for genomic testing at varying times in their clinical course. Patients with disease with fewer or no standard treatment options are candidates for early molecular profiling in the hope that they will be a candidate for a clinical trial evaluating a particular alteration. In general, early-stage patients undergoing definitive treatment do not typically require somatic gene panels.

Molecular Tumor Board

As the scope of precision oncology expands, there is an increased need to include multiple domain experts in decision making using massive amount of tumou information wisely. Either virtual or real-time molecular tumor boards are accomplished. Members include medical, surgical, and radiation oncologists complimented by pathologists, genetic counselors, and research staff. Additional expertise is often required are molecular pathologists and molecular geneticists. Multiple databases are publicly available for searching during molecular tumor boards to help in making variant-therapy associations.

The World Health Organization defines sexual health as a state of physical, emotional, mental and social well-being in relation to sexuality; it is not merely the absence of disease, dysfunction or infirmity. Sexual health requires a positive and respectful approach to sexuality and sexual relationships, as well as the possibility of having pleasurable and safe sexual experiences, free of coercion, discrimination and violence.

Every normal human has physical and emotional changes that occur as a person becomes sexually aroused and participates in sexually stimulating activities which include intercourse or even masturbation. Males

The phases of Sexual human response according to Masters and Johnson and Henry Kaplan are divided in four phases: Excitement & excitement, plateau, orgasm, and resolution.

Understanding our body's response to each phase can help us increase the understanding of the sexual problems and also increase intimacy.

Both men and women experience these phases, although the timing usually is different. For example, it is unlikely that both

partners will reach orgasm at the same time. In addition, the intensity of the response and the time spent in each phase varies from person to person. Sexual dysfunctions can occur during any phase of the human sexual response viz: low or high desire, arousal issues like erectile dysfunction in men, diminished lubrication in women, ejaculation issues in men and orgasmic dysfunctions.

Sexual dysfunction is any physical or psychological problem that prevents you or your partner from getting sexual satisfaction. Male sexual dysfunction is a common health problem affecting men of all ages, but is more common with increasing age. Treatment can often help men suffering from sexual dysfunction.

The main types of male sexual dysfunction are:

- Erectile dysfunction (difficulty getting/keeping an erection).
- Premature ejaculation (reaching orgasm too quickly).
- Delayed or inhibited ejaculation (reaching orgasm too slowly or not at all).
- Low libido (reduced interest in sex).

Man Can survive earthquakes, epidemics, horrors of diseases, and all the agonies of soul, but for all time his most tormenting tragedy has been and shall always be the tragedy of bedroom said Leo Tolstoy. One of the most common issues in the bedroom a man faces today is inability to get and sustain erection for successful intercourse which then leads to emotional dysfunction and avoidant behaviour.

There's no single psychological cause that can trigger erectile dysfunction in men. Instead, a variety of issues can all cause or contribute to psychological ED, such as:

- · Anxiety, whether general in nature or specifically related to sex
- · Fear or sexual failure or poor sexual performance
- · Feelings of guilt about engaging in sexual activity
- Stress about sex or chronic stress related to other issues
- · Depression and other mood disorders
- · Relationship problems
- Excessive porn consumption
- Low self-esteem

Some medications used to treat psychological issues, such as antidepressants, can also play a role in the development of erectile dysfunction. Even if there is an organic cause for Erectile Dysfunction there is always a psychological component which adds salt to the wounds.

Till date there has been no cure for the symptom of Erectile Dysfunction. From the invention of Sildenafil "Viagra" way back in 1998 which was tried for treatment for hypertension, angina etc but a side effect of which was men started getting erections and hence Pfizer grabbed this side effect as a wand to make it a blockbuster pill for management of Erectile dysfunction.

When it comes to treatment for ED we need to know that ED is Endothelial dysfunction which means it could be decrease in eNOS, NO and CGMP or PDE5 inhibition in the vascular endothelium and corpora cavernosa leading to inability of the corpora cavernosa to be fuelled with blood. Hence I also called erectile dysfunction as penile angina or penile attack.

The Current treatment for erectile dysfunction is as follows

First Line of Rx	Oral Drugs	Counselling	Life style Modifications
Second Line of Rx	Intra Cavernous Injections of papaverine & Largactil Vaccum Therapy MUSE	Counselling	Life Style Modifications
Third Line of Rx	Anastamotic Surgeries and Penile Implants	Counselling	Life Style Modifications

But whatever line of therapy one tries it has to be personalized according to the needs and acceptance of the patient. Along with these therapies one thing which needs to be done is Counselling and Advice on life style modification which is the bench mark for the treatment of erectile dysfunction.

The Regenerative medicine which is a new buzz word has shown promising results, but still need robust evidence to imply them into practice, Amongst the Regenerative medicine we have Platelet rich plasma, Stem cell therapies, Gene Therapy, Nano technology and amongst the Phytoneutraceuticals we have L arginine which is a potent metabolic amino acid and Nitric Oxide donor which is available and along with it Fenugreek in saponised form. Both these medical foods can increase the desire and also initiate erections and improve the endothelial dysfunction.

There are various other strategies to improve erectile dysfunction by restoring the endothelial dysfunction. Successful strategies for reversal of endothelial dysfunction are: PPAR alpha and gamma agonists which increase NO production in endothelium; anti-oxidants such as vit. E and C; supplementation with L-arginine, tetrahydrobiopterin-BH4 or sepiapterin (precursor of BH4), SOD mimetic tempol, statins which apart from lowering cholesterol improve NO production, selective beta1 adrenoreceptor antagonists such as nebivolol; suppression of angiotensin-mediated endothelin production by ACE inhibitors and ATR blockers; CB1 receptor blockers, PKCb inhibitors, nitric oxide donors (glyceryl trinitrate and isosorbide dinitrate), dietary supplements of EPA/DHA and regular physical exercise and control of mental stress.

In Diabetics the novel way to treat patients who have Erectile dysfunction is to put them on SGLT 2 inhibitors either Dapa or Empagliflozin along with Metformin both these drugs due to their class properties reduce weight, control hyperglycaemia and also improve endothelial dysfunction. These patients if bring their hyperglycaemia under control which is possible they do not need PDE 5 inhibitors as they get normal morning physiological erections.

With the state of art medical and surgical treatments every phase of sexual dysfunctions in both men and women can be corrected and managed. Sex in the elderly can be a more joyous experience, as one is off the day to day struggles of life like career, bringing up children, menstruation, pregnancy etc and have adequate time to experiment and enjoy to the fullest the most vital desire of humans. Counselling can manage all the sexual myths and ignorance and can create a clear understanding of this normal and natural function of our life.

Today what ever be the cause of Erectile Dysfunction be it vasculogenic, hormonogenic, neurogenic or even iatrogenic all these etiopathologies can be corrected and the symptom of erectile dysfunction can be managed.. Similarly with Ejaculatory issues or desire issues can be managed and if one follows intense lifestyle modification and with counselling Every male Sexual Dysfunction is a Correctile Dysfunction and not a ENIGMA any more...

APPROACH TO JOINT PAIN IN CLINICAL PRACTICE - Dr. HIMANSHU PATHAK

Joint pain is one of the most common symptom with which patients' seek help from a doctor. It becomes very important to deduce arthralgia (joint pain symptom) competently to give an appropriate working diagnosis and to start effective treatment. Important part of management is patient education specially during initial few visits as afterwards there remains high likelihood that patient start searching for some magic potion to get better. This all may lead to delayed diagnosis and sometimes irreversible damage if underlying diagnosis is of inflammatory arthritis. In lecture I will be discussing how to identify inflammatory and non-inflammatory joint pain, initial investigations required and management possibilities. DIABETIC DERMOPATHY

Diabetes is a disease that is rampant in our community. Diabetes is a chronic disease that occurs either when the pancreas does not produce enough insulin or when the body cannot effectively use the insulin it produces. It is a significant contributor of many micro and macro- vascular complications that occur later in life such as nephropathy, cardiovascular complications, stroke, retinopathy, and peripheral neuropathy amongst others. Apart from these, certain cutaneous manifestations are also frequently seen. One of them being, Diabetic Dermopathy which is what my paper is based on.

- Diabetic dermopathy is an indicator of poor glycaemic control. It refers to small pink, tan, red or dark brown lesions or spots on the skin. This diabetic skin condition can form anywhere on the body but more commonly is seen on the shin (most common), front of the thighs, scalp, chest forearms, etc.
 - These spots are round/oval, bilateral (present on both sides at the same time), and somewhat scaly. These lesions appear in clustered patches which over a period of time, become slightly indented.
- The condition is diagnosed by a visual examination of the affected skin and confirming whether
 the lesions are characteristic of diabetic dermopathy or not. Rarely, a biopsy may need to be
 performed to rule out other possible skin conditions.
- The treatment is mainly focussed on prevention. The existing lesions fade away with time.
 Healthy and moisturised skin, that is free from injury will prevent the condition from developing
 further. Hence, patients presenting with such skin lesions are advised to use a suitable
 moisturiser. There is no other specific treatment.
- Uncontrolled blood glucose level is the biggest trigger for diabetic dermopathy. Hence, the most
 important step is to control blood sugar levels. This condition also has a strong association with
 microvascular complications as they also stem from unregulated glucose levels in the blood.
 Hence, it is a warning sign for the patient that strict glycaemic control is now required.

ABSTRACT

Cross-sectional study to find prevalence of hearing loss in patients with Type-2 Diabetes Mellitus, at a tertiary care centre, in Western India Bhavi Desai, 3rd First, Medical College, Baroda

This is an original study carried out at S.S.G Hospital as an ICMR-STS project for which the ethical committee permission has been granted.

INTRODUCTION: Diabetes mellitus is a disease affecting millions of people across the globe. Diabetes is growing challenge in India as well with estimated 9.6 % diabetic population in the age group of 20 and 79 years.

In people with Type II DM, the elevated blood glucose can lead to certain severe and potential health complications, including both macrovascular and microvascular complications. Hearing loss manifests as one of the most common neuropathy in type 2 diabetes but is rarely given that much attention.

People with diabetes or prediabetes appear to have greater incidence and an early onset of hearing loss compared to those without these conditions. According to National Institute of deafness and communication disorders (NIDCD-USA), diabetes related hearing loss starts as early as 30-40 years. The focus of our nation now also involves non-communicable disease like type II DM, which is a lifelong companion. Considering that both hearing loss and DM are significant health issues, it is important to examine the relationship between the two.

To assess the frequencies at which hearing loss occurs

MATERIALS AND METHOD: The cross-sectional study of 99 participants was carried out in S.S.G.H after the due permission from The Institutional Ethics Committee. Confirmed type-II DM patients were enrolled with consent and patients with occupational noise exposure, H/O Ototoxic drugs, F/H/O deafness/congenital deafness, presence/past history of ear infection/history of surgery/trauma were excluded.

Hearing assessment was done by general ear examination which was done using otoscopy followed by PTA.Both air and bone conduction testing was done. The obtained data was thereafter grouped into different grades as defined by WHO and the commonest frequency at which hearing loss occurs was recorded.

RESULTS: There exists a link between type II DM and hearing loss with 66% incidence. With an increase in age ,duration of diabetes, poor glycemic control and treatment incompliance the hearing loss worsens. Also, higher frequencies are affected more commonly.

CONCLUSION: A strong positive relationship is present between DM and hearing loss as determined by varoius variables in the study. It can be used to screen and monitor patients with DM to prevent worsening of hearing loss and start treatment accordingly.
